Dear Member,

As promised, the committee would like to update you about the progress in the search for a new venue to allow the club to continue and get back to our Thursday nights as soon as possible.

We have now investigated the availability and suitability of about 70 venues in and around Aberdeen. As previously stated, some have been ruled out as unavailable or not suitable – or far too expensive. We have been trying to find a venue that still gave the social feel to our club, has a suitable finish to the dance floor, has parking facilities and is still within Aberdeen city.

We have found what seems to be a suitable venue so have decided to scrap the previous suggestion of trying out some available venues partly because of feedback from members about the travel distance for some of these so we will start on the 18th August in the chosen venue and **not** the Axis Centre and we will be happy to have your feedback after you have tried it out.

Our venue for the 18th August 2022, and the immediate future is the Rohaan Café Bar on Burnside Drive at Dyce – Postcode is AB21 0HW. Although it is described as a café bar it has a function area and caters for weddings and other events. There are tables and seating off the dance floor. In pictures on their website these tables and chairs are on the dance floor but when we saw the room they had been moved. Teas and coffees will be available for those who want them at the usual rate of £1 per person. There is also a bar for those of you who previously enjoyed drinks from the bar at the Northern hotel. The times will be as usual 7.30 – 9.30pm.

We will not expect members to renew their membership on the 18th August as we would usually do but will have three weeks to settle in before we do this – 1st September, with fees paid before 29th September 2022. The nightly rate of £4 per person will continue.

If anyone has any questions please get in touch but the committee hope that as many of you as possible will come and enjoy our club nights in this venue.
